FOREWORD

ISO (the International Organization for Standardization) is a worldwide federation of national standards institutes (ISO Member Bodies). 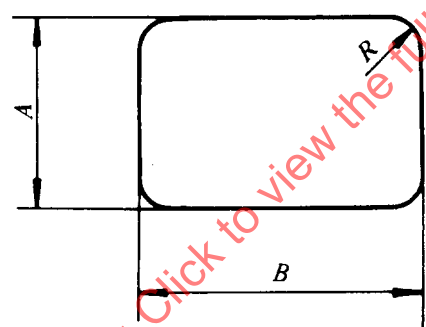
Photography – Cameras using films 35 mm and smaller – Picture sizes

1 SCOPE AND FIELD OF APPLICATION

This International Standard specifies the image dimensions (on the film) of pictures (nominally 10 mm × 14 mm and larger) made with non-panoramic still picture cameras using film 35 mm and smaller. This International Standard does not apply to stereo photography systems.¹⁾

2 DIMENSIONS

The dimensions shall be as shown in the figure and given in the table.
