Coated abrasives — General purpose rolls — Any backing — Designation and dimensions

1 SCOPE AND FIELD OF APPLICATION

This International Standard lays down the dimensions of general purpose abrasive rolls incorporating flanges — any backing — and specifies the designation of these rolls.

2 DESIGNATION

The designation of general purpose rolls consists of the width l , followed by the length L .

Example :

Designation of a general purpose roll of width $l = 25$ mm and length $L = 50\,000$ mm :

General purpose roll 25 × 50 000

(The nature of the backing shall be indicated.)

3 DIMENSIONS

3.1 Widths l (in millimetres)

12,5 — 25 — 40 — 50

3.2 Lengths L (in millimetres)

25 000 — 50 000
